

Have you registered your child's birth?

Did you know...

it is compulsory to register the birth of your child and it is free.

Did you know...

you must register your child's birth within 60 days.

Did you know...

you must register your child to get their birth certificate.

A birth certificate provides legal evidence of your child's age, place of birth and parents' details and is required for some government benefits, enrolment in school and sport, opening a bank account and to apply for a passport.

You can choose to register your child's birth and apply for a birth certificate online or you can choose to submit the birth registration form by post or in person. Birth registration forms are available for download on the QLD Registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages website.
